I have everything I need to fulfill God’s plan for my life at this moment.

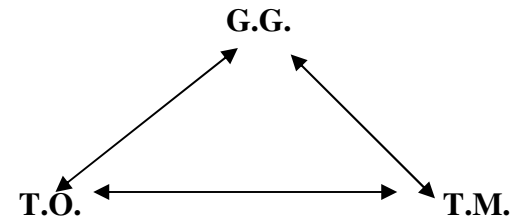
Three Truths About Our Giving God:

1. God’s Power (His ability to give)
1 Chron. 29:12 *“Wealth and honor come from you; you are the ruler of all things. In your hands are strength and power to exalt and give strength to all.”*

2. God’s Provision (His willingness to give)
1 Chron. 29:14 *“But who am I, and who are my people, that we should be able to give as generously as this? Everything comes from you, and we have given you only what comes from your hand.”*

3. God’s Partnership (His reason to give)
1 Chron. 29:14, 16 *“But who am I, and who are my people, that we should be able to give as generously as this? Everything comes from you, and we have given you only what comes from your hand. ... O Lord our God, as for all this abundance that we have provided for building you a temple for your Holy Name, it comes from your hand, and all of it belongs to you.”*
